MAGCON holds at Level 3 – ELEVATED per standing direction. This cycle's reporting shifts to a CONUS-weighted format per operator direction. The reporting window included two significant national anniversaries: the 25th anniversary of the September 11 attacks (11 Sep), marked by heightened security nationwide including a large NYPD/Secret Service deployment in Lower Manhattan coinciding with the start of Rosh Hashanah, and the first anniversary of the assassination of Turning Point USA founder Charlie Kirk (10 Sep), marked by an official “Charlie Kirk Day” proclamation in Utah and continued progress in the Tyler Robinson aggravated-murder prosecution. Separately, CISA added 11 new KEV entries across four batches (8, 9, 10, and 11 Sep) — the most notable a maximum-severity (CVSS 10.0) Cisco Firewall Management Center authentication bypass under active exploitation, alongside a Citrix NetScaler authentication bypass and paired MikroTik RouterOS flaws. At Delaney Hall in Newark, an ICE vehicle struck a protester's foot during a Sept 3 prayer vigil — the second such vehicle-into-crowd incident this summer — which surfaced in reporting only this cycle.

PJM's hot-weather grid emergency from last cycle has resolved: the DOE 202(c) order and Maximum Generation alerts expired as scheduled on 8 Sep with no new stress this window, so Grid/Utilities steps back down to ROUTINE. Government funding, Section 702/FISA, and America 250 remain unchanged. GSX 2026, the major U.S. physical-security industry gathering, opens in Atlanta this week (14–16 Sep) as a non-threat watch item. Internationally, the Strait of Hormuz situation is noted only briefly this cycle per the new CONUS-focus directive: the Iran-Oman safe-corridor deal remains unsigned, and Hormuz oil/LNG transit stays suppressed at an estimated ~7M barrels/day versus ~20M pre-war — a standing factor in U.S. fuel-price exposure, tracked here for that reason only.

PRIMARY RISK DRIVERS

- **NEW — September 11 25th Anniversary:** Nationwide commemorations 11 Sep, headlined by a large-scale NYPD/U.S. Secret Service security operation in Lower Manhattan; officials reported no specific/credible threats but cited heightened precautions given the milestone year and

concurrent Rosh Hashanah observances amid a documented rise in antisemitic incidents citywide.

- **NEW — Charlie Kirk Assassination, 1-Year Anniversary:** 10 Sep marked one year since Kirk's assassination at Utah Valley University. Utah Governor Spencer Cox proclaimed "Charlie Kirk Day." The prosecution of accused shooter Tyler Robinson continues: a judge ruled the case will proceed to trial on aggravated-murder charges (death-penalty eligible), Robinson has pleaded not guilty, and the next court date is set for 23 Oct.
- **WORSENING — CISA KEV:** 11 new CVEs added across four batches (8, 9, 10, 11 Sep), including a maximum-severity (CVSS 10.0) Cisco Firewall Management Center authentication bypass under active exploitation and an actively-exploited Citrix NetScaler authentication bypass.
- **NEWLY REPORTED — Delaney Hall:** An ICE SUV struck a protester's foot during a Sept 3 prayer vigil outside the Newark facility — the second such vehicle-into-crowd incident this summer. The woman is facing likely surgery. This incident wasn't caught in last cycle's sweep; it surfaced in reporting only this week.
- **IMPROVED — PJM Grid Reliability:** The DOE 202(c) emergency order and hot-weather Maximum Generation alerts covered last cycle expired as scheduled on 8 Sep; no new grid stress this window.
- **NEW — GSX 2026:** The major U.S. physical-security industry gathering (ASIS International) opens in Atlanta 14–16 Sep — non-threat watch item for situational awareness.
- **NO CHANGE — Section 702/FISA, Government Funding, America 250:** No material change since the 260906-1800Z baseline.
- **BRIEF MENTION — Strait of Hormuz (international, US fuel-price relevance only):** The Iran-Oman safe-corridor deal remains unsigned as of this DTG; Hormuz oil/LNG transit stays suppressed at an estimated ~7M barrels/day versus ~20M pre-war.

KEY INCIDENTS

CISA KEY — 11 NEW EXPLOITED VULNERABILITIES THIS WINDOW

CISA added 11 vulnerabilities to its Known Exploited Vulnerabilities catalog across four batches this window. On 8 Sep: Adobe Commerce/Magento template injection, two Microsoft Windows flaws (link-following, heap-based buffer overflow), and an N-able N-central static code injection. On 9 Sep: a Fortinet heap-based buffer overflow, a Citrix NetScaler authentication bypass, a Google Chromium V8 out-of-bounds write, and a Cisco Firewall Management Center authentication bypass — the last rated a maximum CVSS 10.0 and under active exploitation. On 10 Sep: two MikroTik RouterOS flaws (missing authentication and command injection) that can be chained together. On 11 Sep: a GitLab Community/Enterprise Edition path traversal flaw, flagged by CISA for mandatory forensic triage under BOD 26-04. The Cisco FMC and Citrix NetScaler entries are the priority items — both are edge-device authentication bypasses with confirmed in-the-wild exploitation.

SEPTEMBER 11 — 25TH ANNIVERSARY COMMEMORATIONS AND SECURITY POSTURE

11 Sep marked the 25th anniversary of the September 11 attacks. New York City held its largest commemoration in years at the National September 11 Memorial & Museum in Lower Manhattan, with the private morning ceremony reserved for victims' family members followed by public access later in the day. Mayor Zohran Mamdani and NYPD Commissioner Jessica Tisch outlined a large security deployment across Lower Manhattan involving the NYPD, U.S. Secret Service, and federal, state, and local partners; officials stated there were no specific or credible threats against New York City but cited the milestone 25th-year significance and the concurrent start of Rosh Hashanah as reasons for heightened precautions, noting confirmed hate crimes citywide were up 16% and antisemitic hate crimes up 9% through the first eight months of the year. A federal bulletin was issued ahead of the anniversary per standard practice.

This year's ceremony added a new moment of silence honoring individuals who died of 9/11-related illnesses linked to toxic dust exposure. No incidents or specific threats were reported in connection with the anniversary as of this DTG.

CHARLIE KIRK — ONE-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF ASSASSINATION

10 Sep marked one year since Turning Point USA founder Charlie Kirk was fatally shot while speaking at Utah Valley University in Orem, Utah. Utah Governor Spencer Cox proclaimed 10 Sep 2026 "Charlie Kirk Day," stating the anniversary should be marked by rejecting political violence rather than deepening division; tributes and campus memorials were held nationally, including at UVU. The criminal case against accused shooter Tyler Robinson continues to advance: a district judge ruled the case will proceed to trial on aggravated-murder charges, which make Robinson eligible for the death penalty if convicted, and Robinson has pleaded not guilty to all counts. Kirk's family called the trial ruling "an important step" in their pursuit of justice; the next scheduled court date is 23 Oct. Turning Point USA's campus tour programming, paused after the assassination, has since resumed. No new threats or incidents were identified in connection with the anniversary as of this DTG; this item is reported for its national significance and the ongoing judicial proceeding, consistent with the operator's documented-activity reporting standard.

DELANEY HALL — ICE VEHICLE STRIKES PROTESTER, NEWLY REPORTED

A South Jersey woman is facing likely surgery after an ICE SUV rolled over her foot during a weekly prayer vigil outside Delaney Hall on the evening of 3 Sep, fracturing her left foot in an incident caught on cell phone video. The marked vehicle, bearing "Defend the Homeland" markings, struck the woman in a driveway typically used for visitor and employee parking as activists gathered during the vigil's final minutes. This is the second such vehicle-into-crowd incident at the facility this summer. The incident occurred within the prior reporting window (30 Aug–6 Sep) but was not identified in last cycle's sweep; it is being reported now as a newly-surfaced item rather than a fresh occurrence this week.

PJM GRID — HOT-WEATHER EMERGENCY RESOLVED ON SCHEDULE

The DOE Section 202(c) emergency order and PJM's Maximum Generation and Load Management alerts, both covered in last cycle's reporting, expired as scheduled at 11:59 PM on 8 Sep with no extension requested. No customer-facing curtailment was reported during the emergency window, and no new grid stress has been identified this cycle. Grid/Utilities steps back down to ROUTINE accordingly.

- Patch MikroTik RouterOS against both CVE-2026-67277 and CVE-2026-86060 — chainable for full compromise.
- GitLab CE/EE administrators: patch CVE-2026-85706 and complete forensic triage per BOD 26-04 (due 14 Sep) if publicly exposed.
- Continue periodic re-verification of magnethf.com's WordPress Core version against the wp2shell CVEs.

General:

- Provide direction on America 250 watch-item reinstatement — still pending operator call as of this cycle.
- No change to standing guidance for Section 702 or government-funding tracking at this time.
- Reporting standard update: civil unrest/extremism items now require a documented, sourced instance of actual violence, a specific threat, explicit calls for/steps toward government overthrow, or documented unlawful paramilitary activity before inclusion — apply this filter going forward.
- Report cyber incidents to cisa.gov or IC3.gov; CI Fortify guidance at cisa.gov.
